GREAT STORIES

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Roll 2 dice twice to locate a table cell. First roll is vertical and second roll is horizontal. 12 = you choose a number. Or use a deck of cards where you ignore face cards and the ace is 11. Taking turns, the family creates a story using whatever words each person chooses. On your turn, locate a cell and place one to three of the words into the family's story. Turn ends after the last word is inserted into a sentence. Turn passes clockwise and the story continues from where it left off. Variations are allowed as long as a majority accepts them.

Use one number in the pair for the vertical grid numbers and one for the horizontal grid numbers to locate something in a table cell. Do this 12 times to find a total of 12 items and write them down on a piece of paper. This will give you 12 things to spot. First person to spot 9 wins. For a variation, trade your lists around so that everyone has to find what someone else determined to be on the list
